


In my work at Family Life I often find it a privilege to work with kids who have such courage and commitment to face issues.

Asylum Seeker Employment Opportunities

Presently there are a large number of asylum seekers being released from detention centres around Australia into the community.

At Urban Neighbours of Hope, we are regularly in contact with people in this situation. Right now the Church in Australia has a great opportunity to respond to the most vulnerable in our midst. **One of the greatest needs for this group of people is employment** - they have work rights, and a great willingness to work.
