### JESUS THE TEACHER

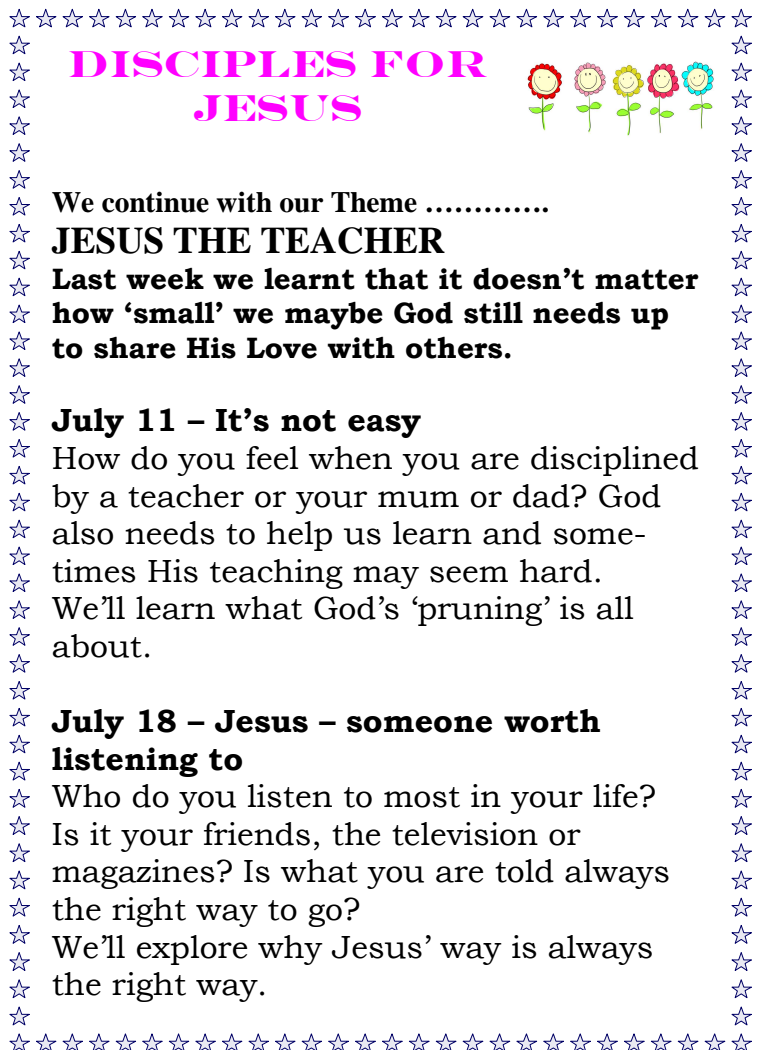
**Last week we learnt that it doesn't matter how 'small' we maybe God still needs up to share His Love with others.**
