Mum was shown sincere and honest love - hugs and kisses and sharing of important memories and laughter over a cuppa afterwards. The familiar music, symbols, repetition and ceremony provided her with a sense of comfort and security. Like a lost sheep, mum returned to the fold affirming her personhood and relationship with God.

I am so thankful that mum's steps were directed back here and back to her Loving Father, as she left this world in peace and confidence of where she was going.

This is the real worth of a Christian community - total love and acceptance to all who have been lost and now are found or are lost and searching for shelter and comfort.
