

Everyone has a story to be shared

As a Christian do you believe there are specific ways you must tell your story? For example: I am a sinner, I met Jesus, my life was transformed.

That can really miss the mark of what others are searching for—a craving for a listening ear. If you enter the conversation with a prescribed intention—to tell your story in a practiced way—then that is not listening well.

You can't listen well when you are carrying an agenda.

You can't listen well when you are looking for ways to fortify your own position.

You can't listen well when you are searching for what is broken in your conversation partner, in order to introduce the solution.

A person who is searching for an answer listens deeply to uncover truth and wants a connection. We need to learn to evangelize by offering and receiving a plethora of stories which may diverge from a single narrative. We need to make space for stories from minority groups.

Connectedness lies in having our stories heard. We earn the right to speak into other people's lives when we have logged enough hours listening to their truths and been willing to be changed by their beauty.
