How healthy are we?

A healthy congregation will be a loving community which expresses its love to:

At the heart of a healthy congregation lies the love for God – flowing from this love is obedience to God's commands, genuine worship and love for one another.

Children who observe and are embraced in this love discover what it truly means to be Christian. They see the meaning of the words they hear in church lived out before them through the week. They come to know a God who is present and active in all life's challenges – the joys and the sorrows.

How can we better engage children in significant learning, authentic worship and responsible service in and through the church's community?

One of the ways I thought was to develop better interaction between the adults of our congregation and the attending children.

This could be by taking the time out to chat to the children, perhaps sit next to them and engage them in conversation in the chapel or invite them to share in refreshments together. Who knows what can develop from this type of relationship?

Could you spare 10 minutes? What about offering to tell them a story in the Children's room one Sunday – could be from the Bible or your own faith journey? You can be a grandparent, aunt, uncle or shepherd to the emerging children in our congregation.
