

#### What does God want of us?

# To act justly and to love kindness and to walk humbly with Him.

To act justly is critical to finding the right way. To neglect justice is to choose to go in the wrong direction—it is to lose your way entirely.

Micah's message doesn't stop at commanding right actions. 'God, he says, doesn't just want right actions, He also requires that we 'love kindness'.

To 'love kindness is to do with our attitudes not just our actions. Our actions are to do with our exterior—loving kindness is to do with the interior of our loves. It focuses on what we are deep down inside.

We cannot separate our attitude from our actions. God sees our heart and judges our thoughts—He knows our emotions and desires.

You may have heard the saying 'as we think—then we become'. If our thoughts are prideful, selfish, judgemental, then sooner or later they become our 'norm' and directs our behaviour.

The Ten Commandments are a very practical sets of rules about actions but if you explore them, you will see there are pointers to the wrong attitude that give rise to the wrong deeds.

Jesus made it plain that attitudes and actions cannot be separated.

So what sort of attitudes are we to have—love kindness. This Hebrew word has a very rich and deep meaning. It has been translated as—mercy, loving-kindness, unfailing love, constant love or steadfast love.

It involves love, mercy and faithfulness.
