

Jesus the Lamb of God

I wonder if you were asked to choose an image for our Spiritual Leader would you choose a Lamb?

We often consider sheep as being pretty stupid and helpless, wandering around. I am sure Keith could regale us about the work his sheep dogs did as they nipped at the heels of the sheep to get them moving in the right direction. The Egyptians despised the Israelites because they were shepherds but they had spent centuries depending on sheep for their sustenance.

When God chose a symbol to depict His liberation of His people from bondage He chose a lamb. From then on the Israelites

sacrificed their lambs to God thanking Him for their glorious release and freedom.

The Israelites also knew the imagery of Psalm 23—their picture of God providing care and protection to His flock. They also knew the dramatic prophecy of Isaiah 53:7,11.— a sacrificial death. That is the reason that the Apostle Paul declared in 1 Cor. 5:7 "For Christ, our Passover Lamb, has been sacrificed."

The figure of the Lamb of God sends strong messages about the nature and character of Jesus. He was God before time began. In the flesh He assumed the role of a sacrificial lamb. Jesus set the tone for us—we should also divest ourselves of all pretense, power and glory.
