help us talk to Jesus.

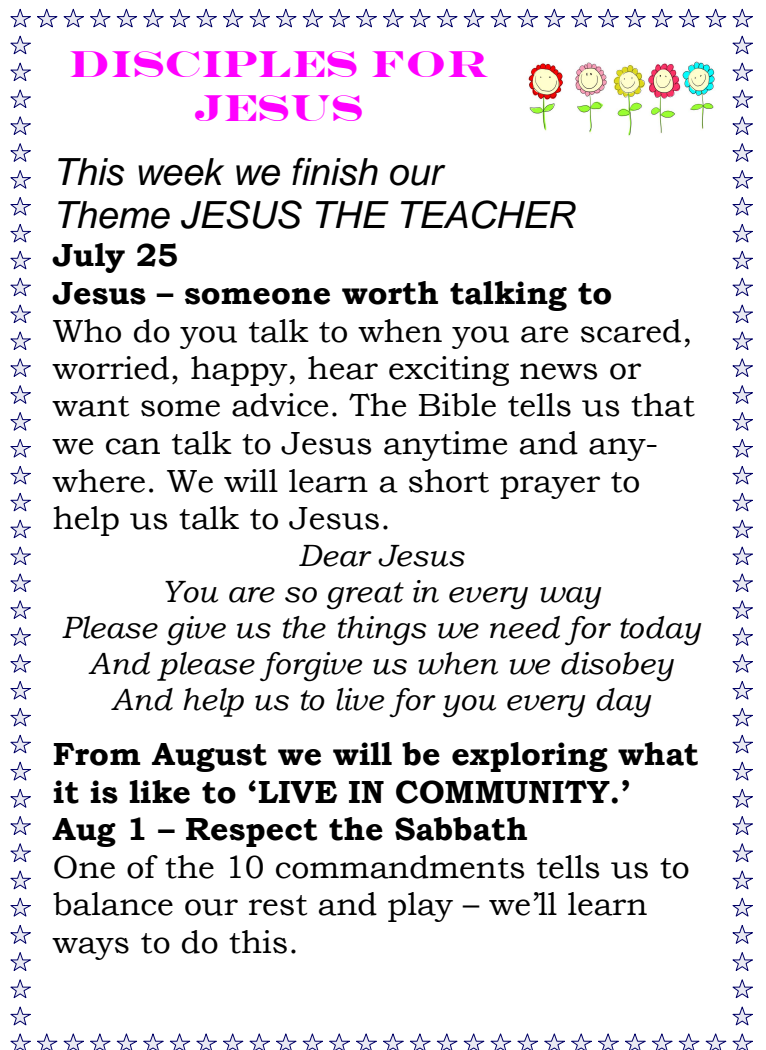
*Dear Jesus*
