However there are over 2,200 people in Burma still in prison only because they believe in democracy. They surrounded the stage with lanterns with Amnesty logos on them. The band followed this with a speech from Nelson Mandela, suggesting that the same people who rose up against Apartied, rose up against wrongful imprisonment in Burma etc.. That group of people is us, whenever we stand together as One. The band followed this up with my favourite song "One" This section of the show was finished off with a rendition of "Amazing grace" It was a great night.
