A WORD FROM THE REV.....

Breaky update: As you know, through amazing circumstances we were able to begin a free community breakfast in February 2009. The impact in our community has been amazing with politicians etc all turning up to have a look. The breakfast has now grown to over sixty participants each Wednesday. Participants include people who are homeless, people with physical and mental disabilities, community workers, families and local business people. Our aim is not so much to provide food, as to provide an environment where people can build community, and those who are struggling can develop a wider social network. It's about teaching people to fish rather than giving them a fish, as effective networks are so critical to everything in our society. As a direct result of the breaky, homeless people have been housed, isolated people have made friends and unemployed people have got jobs! None of this could have happened without Gods guidance, the faithfulness of this congregation, and the willingness to take risks by having a go and seeing if it works. Today many people's lives are better off than a few weeks ago, because of your faith in following Jesus. Whether you contribute through volunteering, prayer, tithes, encouragement or helping the church to survive till now, your contribution has been a blessing. Thank you
