explore life in Bible Times.

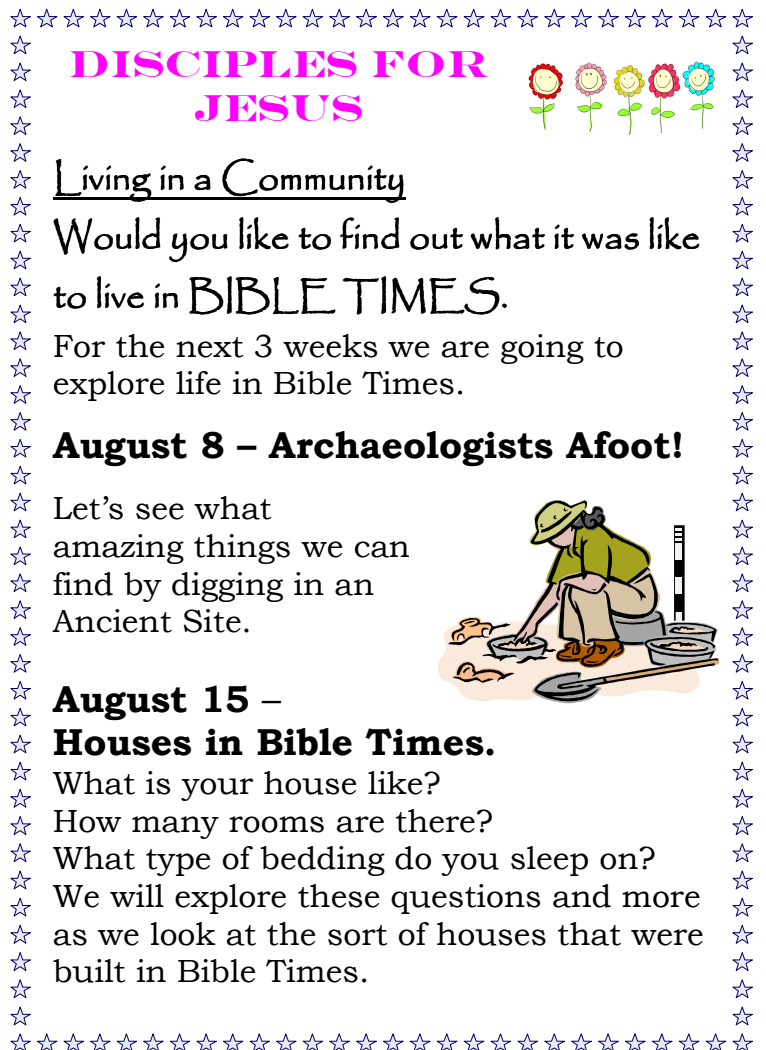
### **August 8 - Archaeologists Afoot!**
