The church also is playing host to a number of new community activities such as: Music with Mummies; School Holiday Program; Karate Group as well as our continuing regulars— Agestrong, Pulmonary Rehabilitation Group as well as the Chelsea Men's Shed.

All these groups contribute significantly to our operating costs of running the facilities as a church in keeping with our Christian Mission as a Community based Church.

In addition, through Chelsea Careworks, we are also providing an increasing number of programs and activities for our community that demonstrate the openness and welcoming that are the hall-marks of our Chelsea Community Church of Christ.

These programs include: Ladies in the Shed which now numbers 8 participants every Monday and, through the demand of the community we may be running an afternoon program to cope with the numbers. During the next couple of months the computer café will be up and running which allows members of the church and the community to access computers on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays with a helper being available.

In conjunction with our colleagues at the Uniting Church, the breakfast continues to be an important activity that is attended by many in the community who struggle financially and face social isolation.

In closing, parishioners are able to see that the Church is moving successfully in its endeavours to be a Community Church that is open to all and we the Church welcome them generously in the Spirit of Jesus.
