#### **HOW ARE YOUR SENSORY LEARNING LOOPS?**

God wired our brains with "loops" so that His truth could fasten to our lives., He put "hooks" in the way the Bible is communicated—both by the authors' inspired messages and the processes He has shown us—so that truth will stick.

God intended for us to use our sensory learning loops—sight, hearing, touch, smell and taste—to remember His Word. But the deluge of information we face today, impacts how we retain God's truth.

Did you know it took 38 years for radio to reach an audience of 50 million, TV took 13 years and the computer 4 years. Yet the number of daily text messages exceeds the population of the planet.

People are increasingly choosing to receive information in non-print form and if we need to know something, we just type it in, download whatever we need, whenever it is needed.

That is really depressing news for those of us who take seriously Jesus' Great Commission to make disciples of all peoples.

# Velcro makes things stick.

So what if we used stories the way Jesus did? What if we used all of our senses to make truth stick. People can more easily embrace God's ways when they can see, hear, smell, taste and touch the gospel.

Bible stories ARE the Word of God and telling them in creative and enjoyable ways will result in the messages sticking easily, like Velcro; instead of sliding off like Teflon.

Last Sunday I invited you to take time to discern what God is calling you to do, as you serve in His Church. The following are some of the tasks, but you may identify others. you wish to consider and seek God's guidance on.

Setting up/packing up chairs in Chapel and setting up/packing up tables/chairs for morning tea.

Setting up morning tea and serving to people, rather than them serving themselves. Placing dishes/cups in the dishwasher.

Emptying bins and placing full bins near the nature-strip.

Weeding the front garden on a regular basis.

For the following, some pre-training is appropriate.

Serving Communion—2 people required each Sunday, procedure to be learnt.

Reading Scripture—Scripture must be pre-read prior to the service.

Leading the Service- an Order of Service is provided to guide.
