

DOES PRAYER MATTER?

Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you wil find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened. (Luke 11:9-10)

Have you ever prayed for things and it just didn't happen—you were left feeling like you cannot trust in prayer, that God didn't live up to His end of the deal and now you are feeling hopeless?

These are what are known as the **sharp edges of faith** in an all-powerful, personal God. Many of us will react with anger or withdrawal when we feel God has let us down by not giving us things we felt were legitimate requests; or judge that our expectations of God were too great; or we lack something in ourselves and we compare ourselves with others.

If we allow this disappointment in God to fester and eat away at our faith in Him we may find ourselves bereft of belief. When belief in God becomes difficult we tend to turn away from Him—but then where do we go? We may even give up believing that God's even there.

Prayer is the irrepressible cry of the heart at the times we most need it. Prayer is far more complex than some make it out to be. There is much more involved than merely asking for something and receiving it.

For every person who feels that prayer has not "worked" and that God has abandoned them, there is someone else for whom prayer remains a vital part of their life, sustaining them even when their prayers have gone unanswered because their belief and trust are not only in the power of prayer but in the character and wisdom of God.

When God is the focus of our prayer, He sustains and preserves our faith.
