DISCERNING THE BEST CHOICES

The Bible is especially designed to help us make the most important choices. The most important choice we will ever make in our life is to repent, change and follow Jesus Christ for the rest of our lives.

We all have various choices to make throughout our lives. Many are daily ones—will I buy white bread of wholemeal? Will I have cereal for breakfast or bacon and eggs?

We also have major choices—like where we are going to live, who we are going to marry, what sort of friends do we want, what church will I attend?

What does the Bible say about making choices?

Scripture helps us know how to make good choices. Such as:

Proverbs 2, 3, 11 and 18.

If a possible choice requires us to disobey Biblical principles then this choice should be deleted.

Carefully weigh the pros and cons.

If the choice is still not clear you may need to take further time to pray and meditate on God's words.

Sometimes you may still be tossing up between a few choices and, if this is the case, it is good to choose one and go with it as indecision and inaction can sometimes be worse than a less-than-perfect solution.

When we strive to seek God's wisdom and follow Biblical principles we can entrust our choices and the worries that naturally accompany them to God.
