WORSHIP SERVICES FOR JUNE

Changes whilst the current Covid lockdown is in place:

The only tenant allowed are AA who meet on a Thursday from 10:30am to 1pm.

Sunday Church service is Live streamed at 10am.

Big Breakfast is Take-away only from 7-10am and Food Pantry is from 7-11am. You **MUST** wear a Mask, sign in with QR code is preferable, but completing the paper log is allowable.

Building Fund: We have raised \$2700 so far—heading towards our goal of \$10,000.

The roof works will commence once lockdown has finished. This will mean there will be some scaffolding around Hope Cottage so car parking will likely be reduced. Signs will be in place.

Our next step is to replace the windows along the front and western side of Hope Cottage. These will be made of aluminium as they last longer. During this time around 20 weatherboards will need to be replaced and once this has been done, repainting can commence.

As we continue this journey the Board is investigating other avenues for funds to complete these works.

The Glade Community Garden: JesseRose and her children have been working hard in the garden with support from a few others. What excitement it is to eat some of our “home grown vegetables.” Any voluntary assistance would be appreciated.

Hope Group: We had planned to commence our new Hope Group on Sunday 20th from 12noon to 2pm, however this will be dependent on any Covid restrictions.

Women’s Bible Study: Exploring Joshua—a man of faith. Also postponed.
