Amazing Grace, how sweet the sound, that saved a wretch like me I once was lost, but now am found, was blind, but now I see.

This beautiful hymn was written by John Newton in 1779. He was once a slave trader, then converted to Christianity. He wrote this hymn as his summing up of the doctrine of grace for every Christian.

In the fifth century there was much debate over the role of God's grace in Salvation.

Augustine of Hippo argued that people were unable to save themselves and were therefore wholly dependent on divine grace for salvation. Pelagius, a British Monk disagreed and said humans had the ability to believe and obey. Debates over grace continued in the ensuing centuries.

However, most theologians in the history of the Church have rightly recognized the need of divine grace for salvation.

What is grace? Grace is the unearned favour and enabling power of God. Salvation comes not through a person's ability to perform a certain number of good works, but rather through a relationship with God by faith in Jesus Christ.

Grace and mercy lie at the heart of the Christian faith. God is the author and source of both. By grace, He gives undeserved blessings to His people, enabling them to walk in His will. By mercy, He refrains from imposing the punishment they deserve. Both grace and mercy are received through faith.

The fullest expression of God's special grace is Christ's death on the cross and His resurrection. Grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.
