

BE A BELIEVER WHO BELIEVES

Who and what do you believe in? For Christians the act of believing is more than marketing magic or advertising fodder. It means placing our full trust in the truthfulness of the Word of God and committing ourselves by faith to Christ and His Kingdom.

Believing in God is our trademark, for without faith it is impossible to please Him. Those who come to God must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who diligently seek Him (see Hebrews 11:6).

Ours is not blind belief. We don't believe in God *despite* the evidence but *because* of the evidence. The Bible commands us to "believe on the Lord Jesus Christ," to trust in the Lord with all our hearts and to live by faith. (Acts 16:31; Proverbs 3:5, Romans 1:17).

When we do that, we're called *believers*. Anyone who believes in Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour is a believer. That's one of our titles, and that's our trademark.

In the Gospels, Jesus often measured the faith of His listeners. He spoke of their little faith and their great faith. If you are anxious and worried today, seek out the Bible's promises about God's care and believe what He tells you, for He said: Do not be afraid only believe (Mark 5:36)

Believe in Jesus as Saviour, Lord, sustainer and supporter of your life. If you are having trouble believing just now, take to heart the words of the distraught father in Mark 9:24, who told Jesus "Lord, I believe, help my unbelief."

For us, every day is *Believe Day*—don't be belief impaired, be belief inspired—a believer who believes.
