Sharing our stories

We live in a society where most of us are struggling with something but very few of us are willing to share our truth. We struggle between wanting to share our lives to not wanting to share anything at all; to sharing the good things and not the messy parts, the hard parts, the parts that twist your stomach into a million butterflies. Here are 6 reasons why we need to share our stories:

- <u>Connection</u> keeping things to ourselves build walls around us and we become isolated. When we start to share our stories, we find others who get us; hear us; see us for who we truly are. And we realize we all have imperfect parts and we can embrace imperfection together.
- <u>**Depth**</u> digging deeper into our story leads to courageous living. We can reflect and step outside of our comfort zones and grow.
- <u>**Permission**</u> –When we share our stories about the struggles we are dealing with, we send out messages to others that we are a safe place where they can talk about their issues.
- <u>Authenticity</u> when we truly listen to one another and give them our undivided attention we are saying we see you, you are real and this goes both ways.
- <u>Awareness</u> Today we don't talk about our insecurities, struggles, lack of self-love in our lives or problems with relationships. We don't ask for help because we fear we will look weak. But we have to be brave enough to share our stories, in order to change and to be the example.
- <u>Community</u> When we find other people like us, we feel less alone and more connected. Like we belong and it feels like home. As a community, we can start inviting others in and share our stories with them. We can create a welcoming and warm community. One built on love, connection, authenticity and story-telling.
