I have been reading a book titled: "A dare to live fully right where you are-One Thousand gifts." by Ann Voskamp.

It is quite powerful reading. For the author experienced a tragic loss and was struggling to see where God was in all of her pain. The author gently teaches how to biblically lament loss, turning pain into poetry; intentionally embrace a lifestyle of radical gratitude and slow down and catch God in the moment.

The challenge is to start to record the gifts and items of gratitude that you experience every day until you have recorded 1000. Now this may seem difficult, however just this morning I went for my usual walk. I was grateful for the sun starting to shine; for the many dogs that were playing; for a boy and girl riding their bikes while their dad jogged beside them; for my ability to be able to walk and talk and think and laugh.

You see, we often focus more on the things we are not happy with and completely overlook God's wonderful world that He has created for us. From the garden in the beginning, God has had a different purpose for each one of us. His intent, since He bent low and breathed His life into the dust of our lungs, since He kissed us into being, has never been to orchestrate our ruin. In 1 Corinthians 2:7 we read: "His secret purpose framed from the beginning is to bring us to our full glory."

God means to rename us—to return us to our true names, our true selves. He means to heal our soul holes. He means to fill us with glory again—with glory and grace. I have prepared a small booklet to start us all to record things we are grateful for. I encourage you to consistently undertake this task as it will change how you live.

Alpha Course commencing:

Judi and Fiona will be conducting an Alpha course which runs for 12 weeks. This will be held every Monday evening from 5.30 to 7.30/ with one full Saturday which covers 4 short lessons starting at 10am, break for lunch and finishes at 2pm.

We will commence our first session with provision of a light meal for all and hope this becomes something participants are keen to continue as the course progresses. However, if you wish to come after your dinner, please arrive at 6.30pm.

It would be helpful to let Fiona know if you are attending—this will assist with catering and materials provided. We already have 4 starters for this which is great.

This past week we have commenced two new partnerships—one with the Chelsea Kingston Library and one with a family run Aged Care business with their Parkdale site.

We have been successful in receiving two small grants—one to assist with the Pantry of \$1000 and one to purchase necessary items and rebuild the table in the kitchen to create drawers for storage underneath for \$2000.

Pastor Judi will be meeting with a City of Kingston Rep to discuss ways the Council can best assist our Community Outreach with resources or perhaps more funding.

Mission Envelopes:

A great suggestion was raised by one of our members which we are going to introduce. Each member will be provided with sufficient envelopes for 3 months to assist with their tithing.

As well we will provide a 1 months supply of envelopes marked "Mission." Each month we will be collecting for a specific Mission Program such as our Pantry, Breakfast, Maintenance or other identified need. It does not matter if you put in 50¢ or \$1 as anything will provide extra \$\$\$ that we need.

Assistance from the community:

I think it is important for you to know that many of the people we serve throughout the week, such as breakfast and pantry have been stepping up and eager to lend a hand where they can. Two of our participants are going to repair the back fence after it blew down in the strong winds. Trevor completed painting and is keen to assist again where he can.

Our visit to Beryl—4 of us popped down to Korumburra to hold a prayer meeting/bible study with Beryl and a few of the ladies she now has contact with. It was a great time and we were introduced to an organization called "House of Hope" which raises funds with 100% going to 43 orphans in Uganda. Beryl has asked if anyone has items they could contribute for their new shop to sell either on commission or as a donation. Please see Judi is you wish to know more. You can also do a one-off donation or a regular monthly amount.
