How to Stay Focused

- Have made a public testimony of faith in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour

Members must have been baptized or are in the process of being baptized.
Or are seeking to transfer their membership from another church.

Christians in Fellowship may just wish to identify and worship with the Church as part of their journey of faith.

Being a Member enables you to vote on various policies and procedures of the Church and serve in various roles, including being a member of the Church Board.

What is a Parable?

An interesting lecture this week looking at what a parable is. Have you ever wondered about the message that lies under the surface of the intended message? The book of Matthew is a book that holds most of the parables taught by Jesus. Parables that provide us with Christological directives on how we are to live the life we have been given; regardless of generation. But what's the underlying theme of parables as a whole. To appreciate the teachings of Jesus we need to go back to Genesis, where God created the earth and man and woman in His image, but what does "in His image" mean? Pentecost: will be held at the Baptist Church in Bonbeach. Any ideas are welcomed.

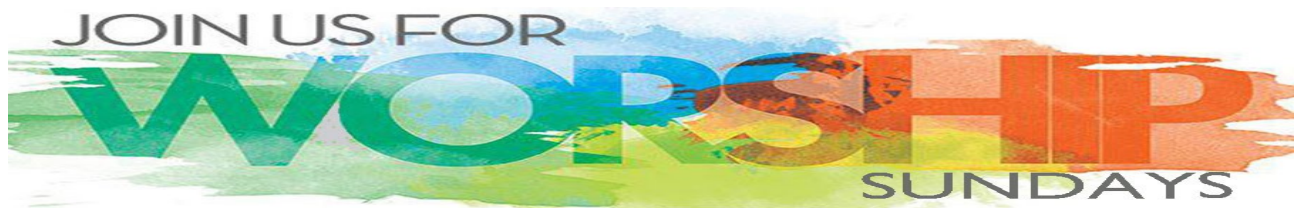
Maundy Thursday: Pastor Judi will be conducting the service on behalf of our church and the Uniting Church. This will be held at 6pm on Thursday 18th April.
