<u>Ready</u> In 2014 the HoChiMinh City Bible School in Vietnam was attacked and destroyed by hired thugs and police. This school trains young Christians. These young Christians were attacked, injured and had personal property stolen or damaged.

Yet, in spite of this students continue to attend all for the privilege of gaining knowledge of the Word of God and spreading that knowledge throughout Vietnam.

Think about what you had to do the last time you wanted to grow in Spiritual maturity—drove to Church, attended Bible study, went online or grabbed a book from the local bookstore. Unlike these students the only cost would have been the investment of time and energy.

Question: If you faced the same opposition as those young Bible students would you have continued to pursue the knowledge of the Bible?

Another question: given the lack of obstacles we face as Christians in Australia, are we taking advantage of our freedoms to learn and grow? Or are we learning just enough to get by—just enough to qualify as "Christians?"
