

## THE BOOK OF PSALMS

For the next few Sundays we will be looking at a few of the Psalms. The book of Psalms, a collection of 150 lyric poems, is probably the most frequently read book in the Bible. It is also quoted more frequently in the New Testament than any other book of the Old Testament.

Psalms provides instruction, inspiration, motivation and consolation. It is Hebrew Poetry, characterized by a rhythmic arrangement of thought patterns.

Psalms can be characterized as:

- Psalms of Praise—Psalm 19
- Historical Psalms—Psalm 105
- Ethical Psalms—Psalm 8
- Psalms of Penitence-Psalms 6;32;38;51 and 143
- Prayer Psalms-Psalms 35;69;109; 137
- Messianic Psalms-included in Psalms 16;22;41;110
- Ceremonial Psalms-Psalms 30 and 90.

Psalms affirms that Jehovah is the creator of the universe and the maker and preserver of man.

Psalms are as fresh today as if they were written yesterday. How can this be?

Because they were invigorated by the Spirit of the Living God.
