God Never Wastes an Experience.

Romans 8:28—in all things God works for the good of those who love Him.

No experience is ever wasted if you use it wisely. God can use what you've been through to develop you into the person He intended you to be. Moses grew up in a foster home. As the adopted son of Pharaoh's daughter he spent 40 years learning the language and ways of the Egyptians. What better preparation for understanding your enemy than being raised among them?

But Moses needed to learn other lessons too, so God took him into the desert for another 40 years to tend sheep. God taught Moses how to identify with hurting people and when Moses was 80 years old, this experience helped him lead the people of Israel.

Moses was afraid at first and made up lots of excuses but he did a brilliant job. The point is this: Moses' 80 years in training weren't wasted. 40 years in a palace prepared him to deal with Pharaoh, and 40 years as a shepherd prepared him to lead God's people through the wilderness to their destiny.
