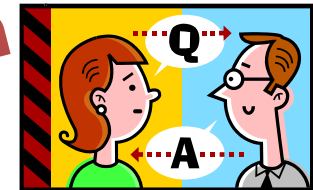


7 SECRETS TO A MORE GENEROUS CHURCH

1. Acknowledge God's generosity — we possess nothing to give that has not already been given to us from God.
2. Generosity is not primarily about money — the generosity of God, Jesus and so many in giving their resources, talents and time is in the joyful mission of God.
3. Model a generous lifestyle — we need to live showing our trust in God enough to live simply, give sacrificially and engage with the community.
4. God repays those who are generous to the poor — but we need to teach responsible use of money as a blessing and not as a god.
5. Giving is at the heart and foundation of biblical generosity — this is the very nature of the Trinitarian God who is an eternal community of self-giving love and deference.
6. Expand our metrics—an increase in monetary giving may be a wonderful thing but it alone does not signify a generous congregation.
7. Attitude is as important as action—the Israelites were taught how to give — with humility. We cannot claim credit for our gifts.

We need to model ourselves on Jesus who is loving, humble and servant-giving. Jesus didn't just send food to the tables of the poor, He invites them to share at His table. We must also be welcoming, gracious and free of condemnation.
