If your only tool is a hammer, you tend to see every problem as a nail. Sometimes we are inclined to use a hammer when a gentler approach would do the job better.

On Sunday, I witnessed 4 incidents where hammers were used, including a safety risk in the carpark, which could have resulted in injury to members.

I suggest you try the following:

Temper – when you are upset it is easier to make a big deal out of a little one. So before responding and raising your voice, think before you act. The problem increases when you over-react but the problem decreases when you pull back on any reaction.

Timing – when you have over-reacted, relationships are maintained if you apologise quickly. Knowing when to act – and when not to – is every bit as important as taking the right action. The real art of conversation is not only to say the right thing at the right place, but to leave unsaid the wrong thing at the tempting moment.

Total picture – are you inclined to jump to conclusions? Take the time to get the full picture on what is happening, respect another's opinion and decision unless you have 'walked in their shoes' for a time.
