Tithing! One subject that is sure to create debate.

Did you know that the Bible does not teach that tithing is the recommended or the required basis of giving for New Testament believers?

Tithing in the Old Testament was NEVER of money and the New Testament never teaches that, as believers, we should tithe.

The first mention of tithing is contained in Genesis 14:11-24 between Abram and his nephew Lot. Abram gave a tithe willingly and freely.

We read that the sons of Levi would receive tithes from the people according to the law, that is, from their brethren.

Tithing consisted of the produce of the land not money earned by people. It was God's commandment <u>under the law</u> that the Levites/ Priests would get their share of food and that poor of the nation of Israel would also be fed.

So you may say, okay I won't tithe.

Except we are not under the law, we are under a New Covenant. Tithing is not part of the Apostolic Doctrine, however, we are commanded and taught instead to give with a generous heart, motivated by love and as led by the Spirit.

As a small church we continue to struggle to maintain ministerial wages; upkeep of the church and payment for utilities. Our offerings and income do not meet our outgoings.

This message is to encourage each and everyone to go to the Lord in prayer with this issue; to open up to the power of the Holy Spirit and be guided by the response you receive.


