WALKING WITH GOD

Walking with God is to be faithful.

Unfortunately faithfulness is often an overlooked virtue today. Today one of the main motives for doing anything is because you "feel like it" and if you don't feel like it, then you don't do it.

Without faithfulness, love and mercy would just be flashes of emotion. Faithfulness puts the staying power in kindness, it kindles sparks into flames of effective action.

In the New Testament, Jesus is the model for faithfulness. He is obedient to God even to the point of dying on the cross. As God, Father and Son and Spirit, is faithful, so we need to be faithful. We need to be people who treat promises seriously and whose word can be trusted.

To be faithful is also to be reliable. Kindness of any sort, where it is full of love or mercy, means very little unless it is maintained. To love kindness involves desiring 3 things: love, mercy and faithfulness.

It is to long to be someone who cares for other people, who wants their best and who is committed to them. It is to desire to live in a way that is totally contrary to the standards of our world, where putting self-interest and personal pleasure first is the supreme goal.

Kindness has other virtues—it sheds light in the darkness; it breeds kindness and is able to disarm anger and irritation. Kindness is the oil that takes the friction out of life. It is also memorable.
