

SO WHAT IS PENTECOST?

The word Pentecost is the Greek name for the Jewish festival Shavuot. Pentecost celebrates two coinciding events, one ancient and the other ongoing.

The first marked the occasion of Moses receiving the Ten Commandments on Mount Sinai, which had occurred 7 weeks after the original Passover of Egypt.

The second event was the culmination of the Feasts of Weeks. This feast derived its name from the 7 week harvest of wheat and barley, which began at Passover.

The day after this 7 week harvest was designated as a time of celebration and thanks to God, with the Jewish people bringing an offering of the first crops from their harvests to the Temple.

Since that was the 50th day after Passover, it was called Pentecost, meaning 50 days.

This was the time that the Holy Spirit descended and entered the disciples. Although the Holy Spirit is an equal member of the Trinity, many people do not view the Holy Spirit as God. However, Scripture clearly shows that the Holy Spirit is God.

In the Bible:

- 1. The Holy Spirit is called God. (Acts 5:3-4)
- 2. The Holy Spirit is associated with God. (Matt 28:19)
- 3. The Holy Spirit performs the actions of God. (Genesis 1:1-2) and
- 4. The Holy Spirit has all the attributes of God. (Psalm 139:7-8)
