PARABLES OF JESUS

It has been said that a **PARABLE** is an earthly story with a heavenly meaning. Jesus used parables most of the time as they were easily remembered and linked into something in the culture's everyday life. Things such as shepherds, sheep, salt, mustard seeds, soil.

Jesus sometimes took His disciples to the side to explain what a parable meant? We may wonder why, when we also search His parables and are left wondering at the meaning Jesus had in mind. We may ask, as the disciples did—Why speak in stories?

Jesus answered them, "You have been given insight into God's kingdom. You know how it works. Not everybody has this gift, this insight; it hasn't been given to them. Whenever someone has a ready heart for this, the insights and understandings flow freely.

But if there is no readiness, any trace of receptivity soon disappears.

So where do you sit? Is your heart open to really hear Jesus' message or has the lure of this world or fear of commitment drawn you away. Are you fully committed to Jesus or are you only paying Him lip service?

Jesus understood that truth is not sweet music to all ears. There are those who have neither interest nor regard in the things of God. To those with a genuine hunger for God, the parable is an effective and wonderful way to convey divine truth. The stories of Jesus included volumes of truth told in words that contained wonderful imagery that is hard to forget.

So, then, the parable will bless you if you have willing ears, but if you allow worldly things to close your hearts and ears then you will lose a life in eternity.
