From The Ten of Pastor Judi

Do you keeping seeing this sign – STOP? And then you see all kinds of conditions before you can enter.

Did you know that Jesus obeyed the word STOP? Whenever Jesus saw that people needed help, He stopped. Jesus saw interruptions as opportunities to show God's love.

Do you have room in your daily life for interruptions or are you too busy, concerned only about your own needs, that you ignore those who are seeking some compassion and care?

Don't get me wrong, it is very important to care and protect yourself in the world we are living in at the moment. But that shouldn't prevent you from doing what the Good Samaritan did. He saw someone hurt and needing help and he stopped. He had his own busy schedule on the Jericho road that day – but he stopped. In fact he had to go back part of the way he had come because that was the direction for the nearest inn for the injured man.

1 John 3:17 "whoever see his brother (or sister) in need, and shuts up their heart from them, how does the love of God abide in them?"

Luke 7:16 says that whenever Jesus acted out of love, people recognised that God had visited them.

When Di and I go swimming we both have a bible verse to say before we leave the water. Mine is **Psalm 46:10 – Be Still and know that I am God.**

I don't see that happening much today – people are rushing around frantic and agitated – like looking at my washing machine and it is all froth and bubble, everything is tangled together and I cannot identify which clothes are which. But there is hope in your life if you find a quiet place to be with God and come to Him with honesty and openness. Admit you need to change; ask for His guidance; set your priorities but ensure that God's will for you is your first priority – then everything else will fall in place.
