What is a Disciple?

The simplest definition of a disciple is a "learner" or "follower." Socrates had disciples, John the Baptist had disciples and Gandhi had disciples. But to be a disciple of Jesus Christ is unique; it involves much more than following a human leader. Jesus' followers were invited into a special relationship with amazing privileges and opportunities.

In the time of the disciples, if you were called a follower of Christ, people would expect to see your life busy about relationships and reformation. This identify was clear in Christ's day. It is like today when you say: "Oh, he is a truck driver" or "She is a doctor." It spoke volumes about who they were and explained why they lived, thought and acted as they did.

Discipleship requires a basic shift of orientation as we align ourselves with God's will through humbly letting go of our own agendas. To deny ourselves in the context of cross-bearing means that the world will reject us for walking outside of its path, but we are ready to do so, because God has called us to walk in a different way.

Cheap Grace is grace without discipleship, without the cross, grace without Jesus Christ, living and incarnate.

Costly grace is the treasure hidden in the field; for the sake of it a person will gladly go and sell all that they have.

It is costly because it costs a person their life and it is grace because it gives the person the only true life.

Do you doubt that God has called you to be His disciple?
Do you judge yourself harshly by thinking you are just not good enough?

And from this your eyes will be opened to why God has called you.
