LIVING OUT THE EXAMPLE OF JESUS

Behind Every question

We are living in the age where we need to deal with the 'hard questions' posed to the Christian faith. The gospel of Jesus Christ is beautiful and true, yet oftentimes one will ask: "How can it be true that there is only one way?"

Odd isn't it that we don't ask the same question of the laws of nature or of any assertion that lays claim to truth? We are discomfitted by the fact that truth, by definition, is exclusive.

The question really is—how do we know this is the truth?

Three tests of truth must be applied:

- Are the statements always true;
- Are our observations of this truth adequate and
- Does this truth work in real life?

The test of the person, teaching and work of Jesus shows us why He was who He claimed to be and why millions follow Him today. A comparison of Jesus' teachings with any other claimant to divine or prophetic status quickly shows the profound difference in their claims and demonstrations. None except Jesus ever claimed to be the Divine Saviour. His offer of grace and forgiveness by being the perfect sacrifice of our sin so that we might become the righteousness of God is profoundly unique.

The verification of what Jesus taught and described and did make belief in Him a very rationally tenable and affirming fulfilling reality. Our faith and trust in Christ are reasonably grounded and our experience of Him is consistent.

I am convinced that Jesus Christ alone uniquely answers the deepest questions of our hearts and minds—what do you think?
