WHICH IS THE GREAT COMMANDMENT IN THE LAW?

When Jesus was asked: "Which is the great commandment in the law?" He went straight to the heart of our primary purpose. He replied, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind."

This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it, "You shall love your neighbour as yourself."
(Matthew 22:37-39)

In Verse 40 Jesus said, "On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets." These represent all that the Ten Commandments address

The Vertical dimension is to love God with all that we are. To make love for God supreme over love for our fellow man. The Horizontal dimension of a life that honours God has to do with our activity toward those around us – genuine love is always expressed by action.


Latest News


