

What is Prayer?

We all have a sense that prayer is important, but few of us are actually taught to pray. What does it mean to pray? How does one do it?

We tend to make it something mysterious or something you could spend your whole life developing but prayer is simply communication between God and the people He created.

From beginning to end in Scripture, prayer is simply assumed. It's like no one thought to call attention to the concept that it's possible, desirable, and important for human beings to be in conversation with God.

The Bible is a book of stories of how God has worked with people. It's a collection of prayers and songs and letters to and from people who are wrestling to be near to God. And it's a documentary encapsulating all of the stunning and creative ways that God speaks to us and manoeuvres to be near to us.

So if we want to learn to pray, we should start by doing what we find people throughout Scripture doing: simply talking to God. One of the most beautiful prayers in Scripture—Psalm 139—continuously asserts that God is absolutely everywhere. He can't be escaped. So He's right here now, with you. Don't overthink it, at least not for today.

Talk to Him. He is listening.
