Stop being critical

Numbers 12:11 “the sin we have so foolishly committed”

When Miriam criticised her brother Moses because of the wife he chose, the Lord heard and she was smitten with leprosy. Maybe you grew up in a family that was forever finding fault and now you hear the same tone in how you talk to your family or friends.

You can't enjoy God's blessings because you've been programmed to inspect, nitpic and form opinions—usually negative ones.

The Bible says “*if you want to enjoy life and see happy days, keep your tongue from speaking evil*” (1 Peter 3:10)

The definition of the word ‘criticism’ (dwelling upon the perceived faults of another with no view to their good) should cause you to pause and think.

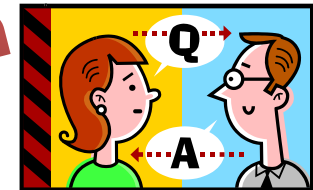
Often your perceptions aren't accurate; there are always circumstances you don't understand. Next we come to the words dwelling upon. We're inclined to walk through life saying—that's not right or I wouldn't do it that way.

You may say—well that is the way God made me. That's fine, but the problem comes when you choose to dwell on your observations—when you can't set them aside. You may say—but how can I help somebody if I don't dwell upon their faults.

But are you forgetting to do this in a non-judgemental way with a view to helping them find a solution.

If you wish to discuss it with a third party—God's way is to end the conversation by saying: “*Let's pray about it, keep it in confidence, and try to help.*”
