

THE BEGINNING OF LENT 18th Feb—4th April

Traditionally we mark Lent by giving something up, but what if it could be more than that? What if Lent was a preparation for a lifetime of big-heartedness?

Lent is a period of seven weeks before Easter when people are especially sensitive to spiritual values and asking questions like:

'Who is Jesus?' and 'What did He come to do?'

For the next 7 Sunday's we are going to be exploring the book of John where we will draw out seven studies from the miraculous signs of Jesus.

The main ingredient of these sermons is the word generosity. We will explore how we can be:

generous with our will and purpose;

generous with our actions;

generous with our possessions;

generous with our words;

generous with our hearts;

generous with our faith and

generous with our forgiveness.

Of course, we can still choose to give something up for Lent—but it needs to be something not just for ourselves but something that gets us out of ourselves and back to God.
