### How to Promote our Gospel with Prayers

This scripture tells of Jesus' compassion when He saw the needs of the crowds, like sheep without a shepherd. He said to His disciples: "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the Harvest to send out workers."  
(Matt 9:35-10:5)

This passage has key insights into what it means to be involved in the mission of Jesus. Jesus felt compassion for the crowds—the words Matthew chose is *Splanchnizomai* which is the verb form of the word "internal organs" - so we may say that Jesus was deeply, inwardly moved.

### What is our attitude towards the 'crowd' living in ignorance or defiance of the true Shepherd?

Jesus told the disciples to 'ask' which is not the usual term for a simple request—it is the more emotive word *deomai* which means to beg or plead.

True disciples understand the plight of the world, feel the compassion of Jesus and beg the Lord of the harvest to advance the work of the gospel. Evangelism is grounded in **heartfelt prayer.**

Jesus presents the connection between prayer and mission. Prayer is the hidden part of our mission but also the basic part. Observing this reminds us that ultimately the mission is not ours but God's. Involvement in God's mission requires

**Faith** more than activism,

**Dependence** more than programs and

**Humility** more than boldness.
