2 Kings 7:9

This day is a day of good news and we remain silent.

The Syrian army had surrounded the city of Samaria and nothing could get in or out. It was a desperate situation.

Eventually the inhabitants began starving to death. Four lepers who'd been quarantined and forced to live outside the city walls decided to go into the Syrian hoping to find mercy and maybe food and water.

But when they got there they discovered an army of angels had scattered the Syrians, who'd fled leaving behind food, water, clothing and treasure. These four men couldn't believe their good fortune! They ate, drank, exchanged their rags for fine clothing, gathered treasure and hid it where they could find it later.

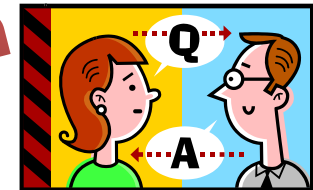
