Augustine said: 'let every Christian understand that wherever truth is found, it belongs to the Master.'

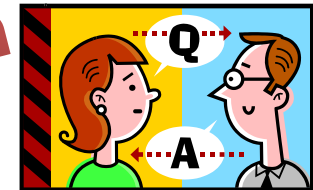
God is the fountain of all truth, and the source of all worthy visions. And since He gave us our visions we must pour ourselves into it every day.
